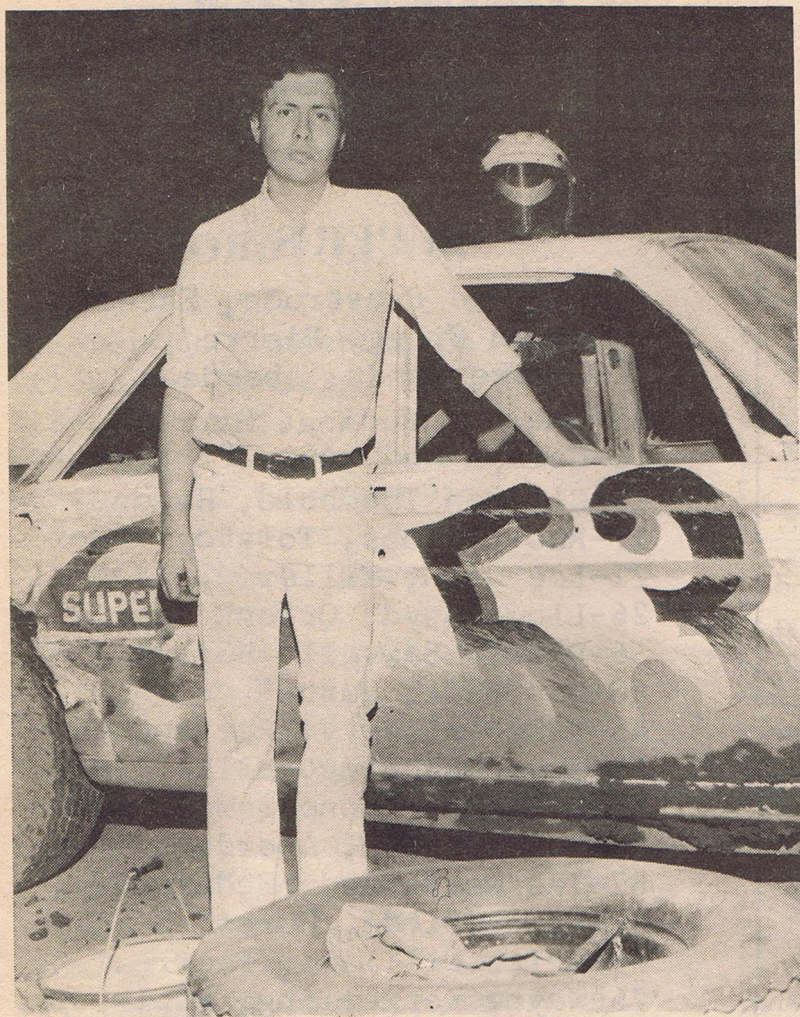


Wayne Manning, No. 53, Miller

Bob Molitor, No. 172, Rockham



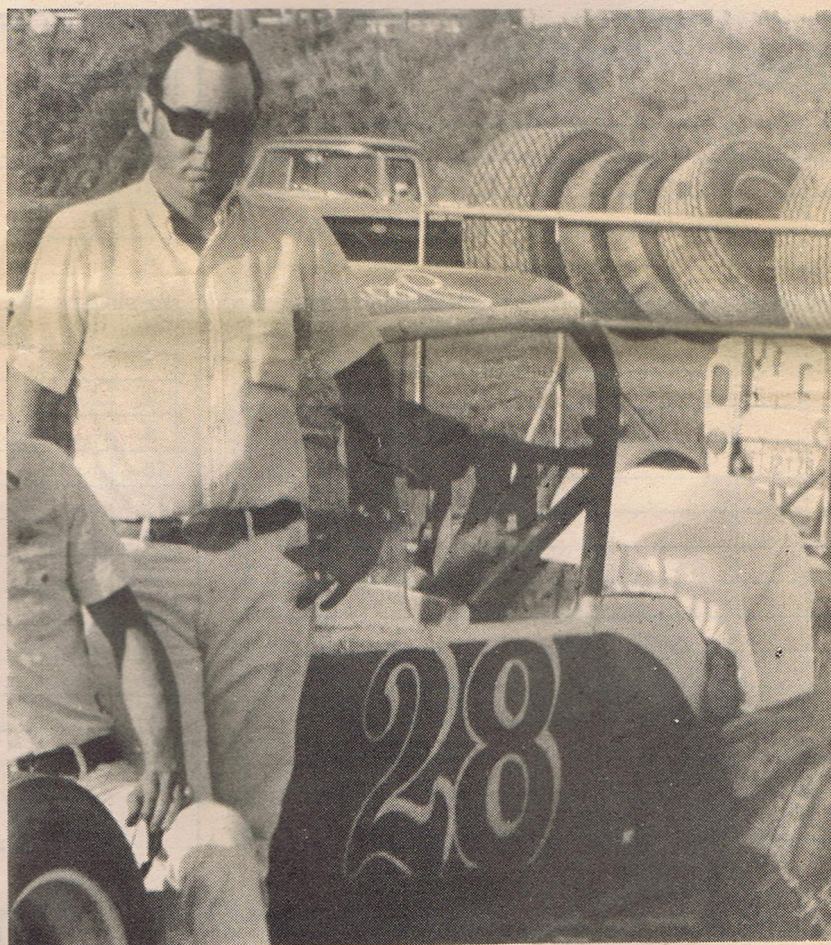
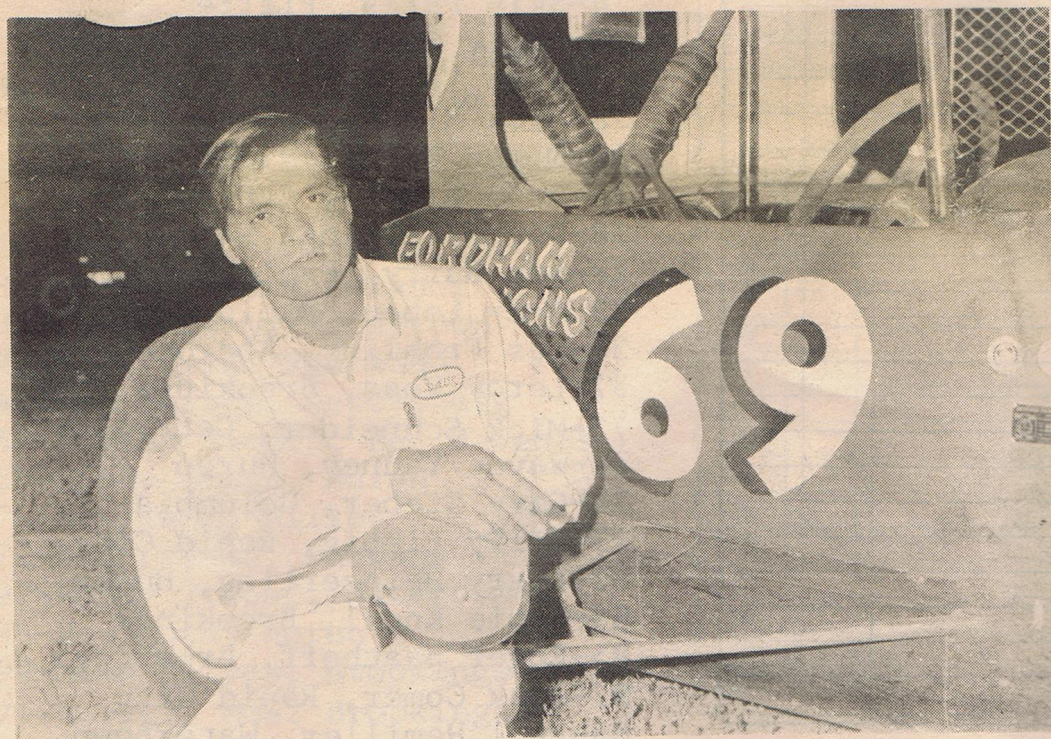
A few dents in a race car? They never hurt anything, at least the way that Bob Molitor's hobby stock racer runs.

der his belt while driving car number 172.

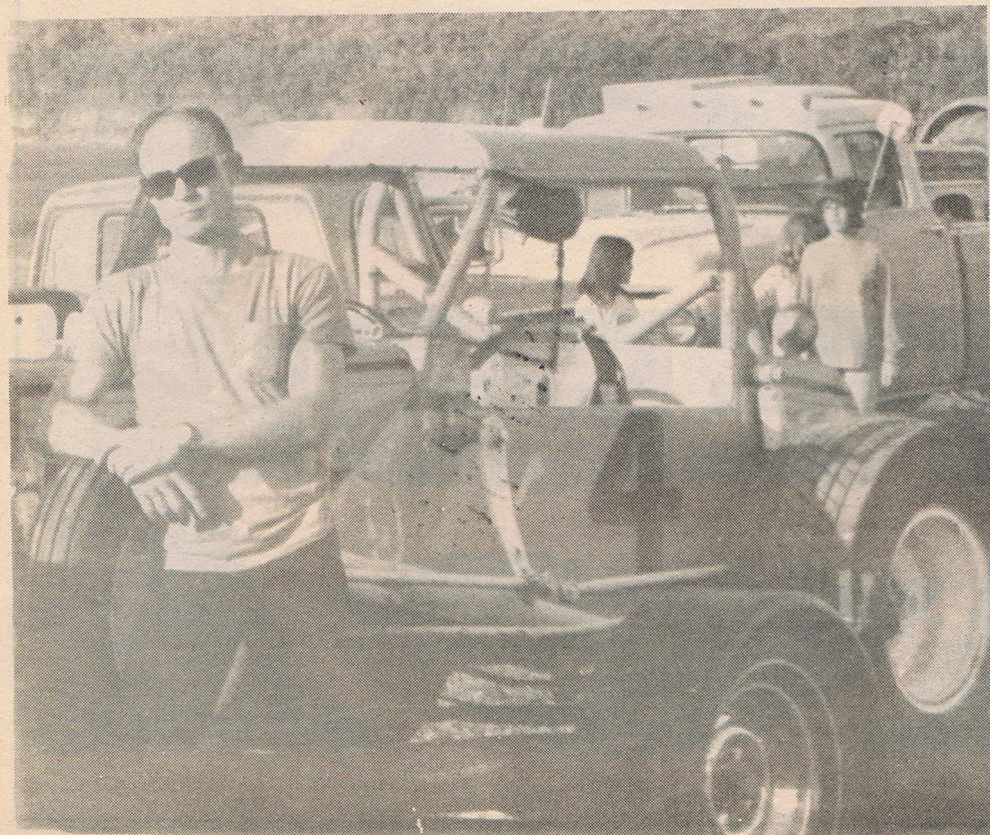
Usually he is not a strong contender in the heat races, but watch out in the feature event where he is expected to excell.
