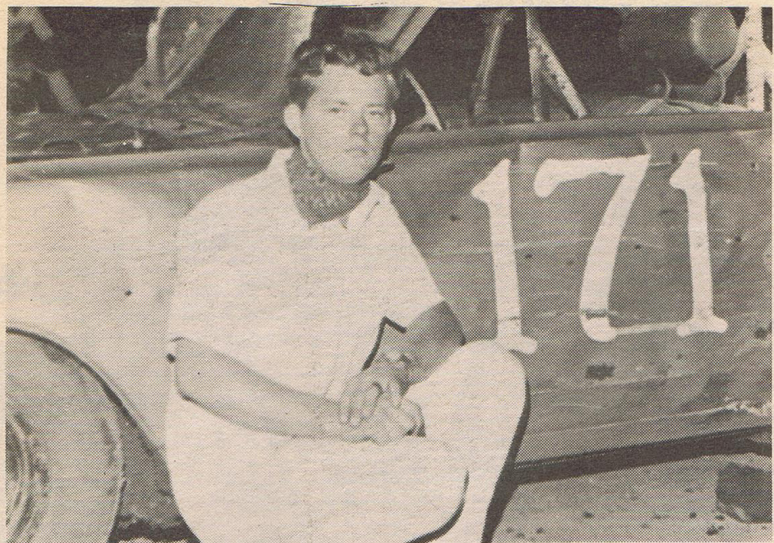


Chet Danburg No. 171, Miller



One of many aspiring Miller drivers, Chet Danburg is one of two Danburg brothers who will be competing in the hobby stock races today.

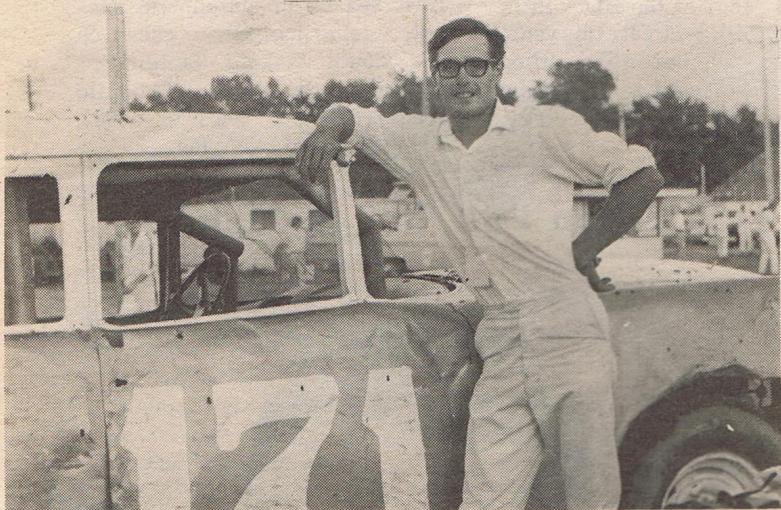
Chet's brother Steve, also of Miller, drives car 111 in the hobby stock division.

He is married, has two children, and has been in racing for three years. Miller is his home track.

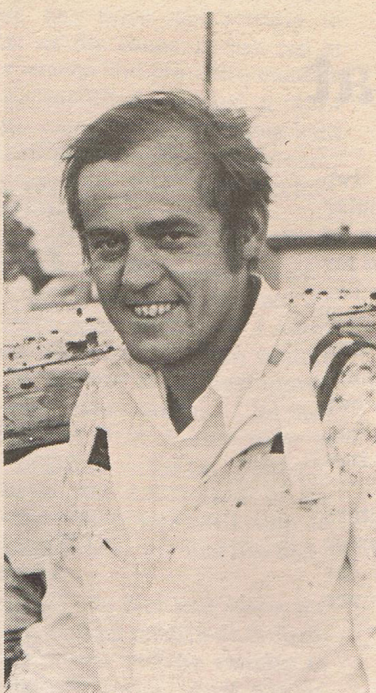
Norrill Moe, No. 171, Brookings

No. 7, Brookings

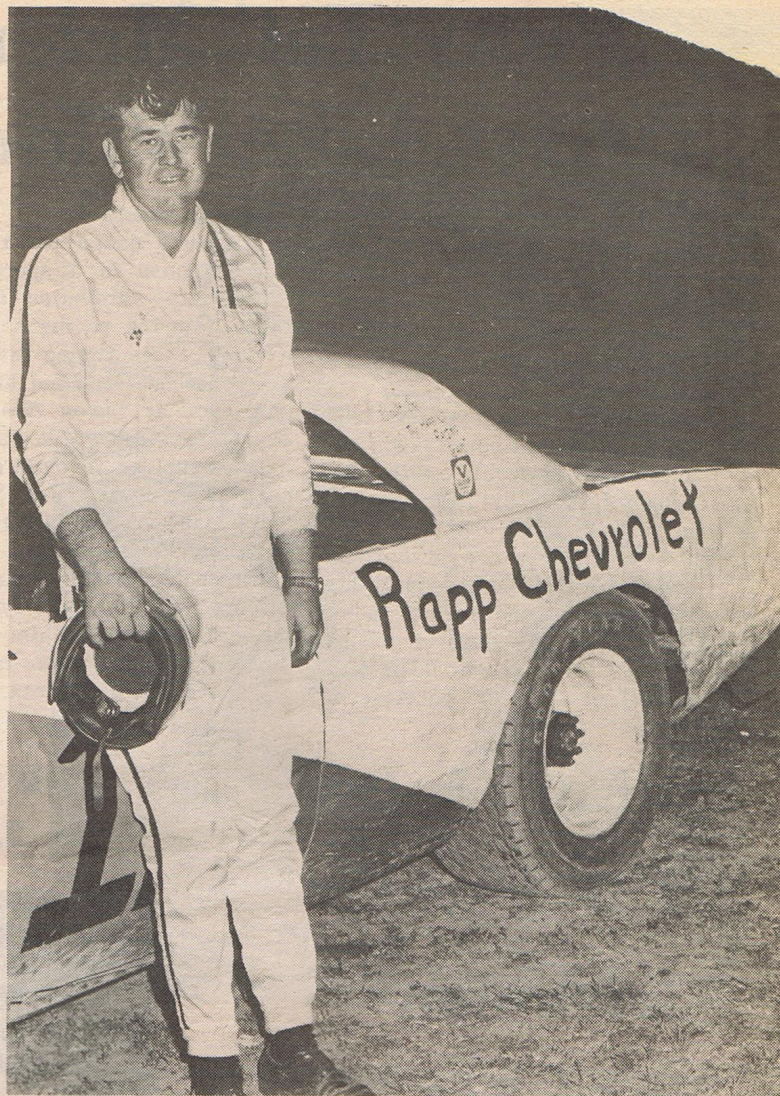


Brookings driver Tony Van Vorst is the fourth place car at the Brookings track in the modified division and has won eighth place at the Huset Speedway this summer.

Redding has been a hard-runner on the State Fairgrounds Speedway this summer and his 427-cubic inch Chevy engine carried him to a new Fairgrounds Speedway record earlier this year. The old record was set by a former IMCA driver during State Fair competition.

He started racing in class C events with a 1955 Chevrolet in 1966. The 27-year old speedster has turned into one of the state's finest stock car drivers and he will be running toward the front in today's superstock feature.
